



Scholarship Application

This General Scholarship is for the class tuition, is up to \$550 and is for training at a woodturning school of the recipient's choice or study with a professional woodturner.

This Scholarship is up to \$250 for the early registration fee for attendance at the American Association of Woodturners annual national symposium.

Scholarship applications may be submitted up to the **February DAW General Meeting** for the year. The DAW officers will review and approve the applications.

Scholarships will be awarded at the **March DAW General Meeting** in amounts decided by the scholarship committee. If a scholarship is received, applicants must wait a year before submitting for another scholarship, (you must skip a year between scholarships).

These scholarships are established to promote the future education of Members of the Detroit Area Woodturners, and the educational classes must be appropriate to the woodturner's abilities. Therefore you must fulfill the following requirements.

1. You must be a member(s) in good standing of DAW for at least a year.
 - a. Participate in at least one half of the "show and tell" sections of the monthly meeting
 - b. Participate in at least one half of the "president's challenge" sections of the monthly meetings
 - c. Offer assistance with at least one half of the set up and or breakdown for the monthly meetings, based on physical health.
2. You will demonstrate or make a presentation at a DAW workshop or meeting.
3. You will write an article pertaining to the experience for the Club Newsletter / on-line article.
