

Barrel Box

- 1. Turn block to a 3" diameter cylinder
- 2. Divide into one third and two thirds and part off
- 3. Make a mortice and tenon box fit and fit together as a single spindle
- With a parting tool, at each end make a cut to 2-5/8 diameter and create a barrel shape. Sand if necessary.
- 5. Find the center of the barrel and make a 1/8 wide Bilge hoop. About 3/16" form each end mark off an 1/8 for the head hoop then split the difference and make a quarter hoop. Use a 3 point tool to create a grove for the burning wire, burn and color with the black marker.
- Using the index wheel and a Copic pen create 24 staves on the barrel.
- (Bigger piece) Take top of bottom off the tail stock end and hollow using a detail spindle gouge or round nose scraper. Hollow out following the outside contour.

Inside the bottom make a small groove for expanding the jaws into. (at home I would use a jamb chuck, cole jaws or vacuum chuck) (Smaller piece)

- Reverse on the chuck and remove tenons leaving about an 1/8" thickness for the barrel staves.
- 9. Mark off the ends of the Barrel staves on each end with the Copic pen.
